“Our New Normal”

Based on Southwest Health District, Idaho Stars, and Governor Little’s Idaho Rebound guidelines the following requirements are necessary to keep NMP&K open:

- *Adults are not allowed in the building.
- *Your child will be met at the side of the building by a staff member. Please stay at the cones.
- *Children will wash their hands prior to entering the building.
- *Staff members will sign your child in and out each day.
- *Please label a water bottle that can stay at school.
- *No microwavable food for lunch.
- *If your child does not feel well, then they must stay home.

This includes, but is not limited to the following:

- fever (100.4 gets sent home)
- coughing
- diarrhea
- vomiting
- chills
- sore throat
- flu like symptoms

*If there is a confirmed case at NMP&K, we will close for 2- 5 days to deep clean.

*Any confirmed case (staff member, student, or family member of student) will require self-quarantine for 14 days.

*At this time, we are unable to hold slots, so if for any reason you need to pull your child, a 30-day notice is necessary.

*NMP&K will not pro-rate nor refund any tuition.

*Please call the school (208 465-6179) for late arrivals or early pick-ups.

Based on Southwest Health District, Idaho Stars, and Governor Little's Idaho Rebound guidelines the following is required of all staff members at NMP&K:

*Staff members will wear a mask and/or face shield

*Staff members will socially distance and model good hygiene.

*NMP&K staff will disinfect several times throughout the day.

*On a nightly basis NMP&K is disinfected.

Please have an alternative plan for your child in the event that the school were to close.
